Daily Living

Daily living courses that cover reading, cooking, orientation & mobility, labels, and vision loss peer support groups.



Braille Education

Braille education by touch and by sight. Materials are made available by mail or online.



Technology

Technology education courses that cover Android, iOS devices, computers, books & TV, and smart speakers.



Workforce Tools

Employment skills workshops that include assistive technology, how to talk with employers about low-vision and blindness, and navigating common software applications.

About Hadley

Hadley is a nonprofit founded in 1920 that provides practical help, support, and community for people with vision loss, as well as their families and professionals. Its programs help individuals adapt to daily tasks and connect with peers, with services delivered remotely via online, phone, or direct mail.

All services are free.

Who Qualifies?

Any Maryland resident who is blind or has a visual impairment that prevents the individual from reading standard print. All ages are welcome, though some courses are geared towards those aged 55 and older.
